- Cristina reads the minutes from June 18, 2024. Vote to accept minutes as read [with minor correction.] Abstain: 1, Nay: 0, Yea: 5.

[7:18 pm] – Kat joins from Lorain County.

- Treasury update (Michael); nothing to report. Education (Michael); nothing to report.
- Kat notes that there are minutes outstanding that she will read during another meeting; she is unable to read minutes for this meeting.
- Public affairs update: Cristina defers to Dave Roberts to summarize the Delaware meeting from last Friday, June 28, 2024 with Eric Dingus, and a panel of others from The Republic for The United States of America and the Tennessee republic offering support and instruction to those men and women settled on the land on Ohio.
