Discussion is had regarding the various aspects the claimant will need to focus on for their peer jurist(s) to properly reflect what the man or woman bringing the claim believes as their basis of right versus wrong, equity and return to honor. Biases, natural law versus code/statute and how the process of Notices plays out at this time were contemplated.

CURRENT GENERAL TEMPLATE for the Jurist Oath of Office (to be tailored by each man or woman bringing claim:

I, _____ affirm and give oath that i will be true to serve under natural law, those living man and woman on the land as a woman who serves as an investigator on a jury (board of review) and will do right by ay and all man and woman; preferring no one through envy, hatred, malice, covetousness or ill-will; leaving no one misrepresented out of fear, favor, affection, reward or enticement; investigating without reserve or restraint, all matters of knowledge or evidence which have been brought forth unto me in such capacity; and shall uphold the law with respect to all man and woman, faithfully, impartially, peacefully, honorably, equitably and never contrary to the laws of almighty God; I shall witness the claim and all facts and evidence to support said claim; I shall render a true and right recommendation without favor, affection, or ill-will, reflecting equal rights and returning all man and woman to honor; so help me God/Creator/Universal Source.

Conclusion: Each participant and those reviewing these meetings after the fact are asked to extract information from the study materials, along with each aspect we have discussed, with a mind to making the language of the texts we are

reviewing more generally understandable, the idea of juror participation less complicated/more modern-day embraceable to the general population.

Everyone participating in these calls, reading the minutes and watching the recordings is called to action in recommending any source of additional guidance and information that could help us structure our process better.

Written minutes, the recordings of these calls and links to future meetings will be posted on Telegram and forwarded through emails provided by participants during the meetings.
