## The Ohio State Jural Assembly Official Weekly Business Meeting Minutes for Tuesday, December 31, 2024

As documented by Cristina, elected as pro tempore scribe for this meeting.

Ross calls for an emergency vote for scribe for tonight's meeting; Cristina accepts the nomination; all members in attendance vote in favor.

[7:08 pm] Ross starts recording and opens the meeting emphasizing we follow Roberts' Rules of Order for Parliamentary procedure and have only peaceful intent. He further explains the purpose of these meetings with OSJA members: to meet, to discuss, and to vote on all matters of concern to the men and women on Ohio.

vote: Abstain, Yea, Nay
Candidate position – name of candidate – direction of vote Abstain, Yea or Nay
Continue similarly to above format down the list of positions
Elector autograph

## Elector thumbprint

Sean Beller offers the suggestion that all paper ballots ought to be retained in the OSJA state archive library of records (in consideration of signatures and thumbprints being potential identity security breach matters.) This was discussed in the prior meeting and agreed upon by The Assembly.
