Unfinished Business

- Jotform. Motion from previous meeting. This application seems to have been wildly over-represented in it's broad range usefulness for the purposes of certification of documents on a weekly basis. Other solutions are being pursued.

- Bylaws. Discussion on multiple conflicts and ambiguities with respect to the various positions listed. Motions to be made in future meetings on specific sections, language, additions and strike-outs.

- Paper ballot vote verification is discussed, moved to the next meeting for completion. Cristina moves (Kat seconds).

- Weekly business meeting via Zoom time or day of week change.

- Board of Review language. Motion language to be presented electronically and by paper before this Sunday's meeting. Kat moves (Kim seconds) to table the discussion for finalization and vote this coming Sunday, January 26, 2025 in Lancaster.
- County Committee of Safety Reciprocal Acknowledgement of Existence/Bilateral Social Compact recognition with the State. Topic is passed over.

Close Old Business – Kat motions; Cristina seconds.

Open New Business – Michael motions; Kat seconds.

- Fairfield County CoS roundtable meeting. Scheduled for this coming Sunday; this will also be broadcast via Zoom. Destry and several others from National-Assembly likely participating, with the intent to clear the air from the previous ill-will between Dave Roberts and Destry so that we may all work side-by-side.
