Cristina states we can't be told by another organization that we have to do it their way; Ohio never ratified under Washington DC to be a state under legal codes/statutes; although our OSJA site is a prototype, the intent is not for other states to just do it the exact same way Ohio is doing it;

Ross states we are in a stall period because the website process is very time-consuming;

Ross states that we had a static site, but we need and are moving to a dynamic site;

Discussion was had about website history – how it started and where we are now;
