Treasury – Keith: The annual post office box payment was made by Ross on 04/08/2025 in the amount of \$105. Keith extended payment of \$13.25 on behalf of the Common Law Grand Jury Commission for his notices to the Fairfield Board of Health. No donations have been received.

<u>Public Affairs</u> – Cristina yields her update of Statewide activities to those members on the call who elect to report on their own county's activities. Bilateral Social Compact language is still being worked on. Michael and Cristina need to schedule their meeting to hammer out the specifics of the 3 - 5 minute video shorts (role plays, podcast type discussions, etc.) for the Education page. Job descriptions are still in progress. Quarterly roundtable meeting is confirmed for 04/26/2025 at 3pm.

<u>Special Committee Report</u> - Grand Jury Commission update (Beverly is not present this evening to give GJ report). – Keith updates on his claim; requests for a court of record have been sent out to several public servants in Fairfield County. Recipients of our notices continue to negatively respond to us, if they respond at all. These replies indicate their bad training,

ignorance of their Constitutional obligations but also show their loyalty to the British Accredited Registry. Keith has begun the process of composing the letter to the STATE Board of Health on this matter. **See recording.**

- Bilateral Social Compact for the counties with reciprocal recognition of the state. North Carolina Buncombe County BLSC is cited as a resource to be included in the COUNTY BLSC update.
- 3. Stark County re-join. No update at this time.
- 4. <u>Fraudulent website.</u> Ross has filed the necessary complaint with Go-Daddy. There is a 72 hour response window, so Ross will update the assembly next week.
- 5. <u>Lancaster County Flag Day community celebration sponsorship</u>. We will be allowed to put up a 10' x 10' canopy with a table for OSJA representatives to 'man' with various handouts. **See recording.**
- 6. <u>Michigan Model</u>. There are a few remaining documents needed to be sent off to various international organizations showing proof that Ohio is de jured.
- 7. <u>Constitutional Sheriff Survey</u>. Cristina needs to update this survey to include Clerks of Courts and Coroners.
