Officer Reports

Treasury – Keith: Donations received on Saturday, April 26, 2025 towards funding the Lancaster Flag Day Celebration \$250 sponsorship fee as follows: Tina - \$40, Patty - \$40, Michael - \$20, Ross - \$25, Cristina - \$20, Susan - \$25, Keith - \$25 (\$195 with a **balance of \$55 due before May 15, 2025**). There was an additional postage charge incurred by Keith for \$6.64 on behalf of the Grand Jury.

Reminder a) expenses directly related to conducting the business of the Assembly NEED to be reported, whether the member is seeking reimbursement or not. As we grow, the transparency of this process may come into question if we are expecting (for example) donated spaces to accommodate drastically larger groups or weekend events, such as that which the North Carolina Assembly is already periodically hosting. [It IS reasonable to anticipate that Ohio will have the same, if not greater, interest in the near future as we continue to achieve publicized successes].

Chair Reports

Education – Michael. No remarks at this time.

Public Affairs – Cristina yields her update of Statewide activities to those members on the call who elect to report on their own county's activities.

Special Committee Report - Grand Jury Commission update (Beverly is not present this evening to give GJ report). – Keith updates on his claim. **See recording.**

Quarterly Roundtable – Ross discusses highlights of last Saturday's meeting. Several recorded statements were made to be entered as evidence for the Grand Jury. Collective re-affirmation of the OSJA covenant of office went smoothly, expect the audio recording to be posted to the website shortly.

Unfinished Business

1. OSJA State officers job descriptions – No recent movement on this outstanding task (since June 29, 2022).
2. Bilateral Social Compact for the counties with reciprocal recognition of the state. Time did not permit discussion of either the State or County BLSC this past Saturday.
3. Stark County re-join. No update at this time.
4. Fraudulent website. Ross updates that Go Daddy clarified that they are the wrong presiding authority to address the problem. Dan Tutolo advised that Google needs to take the corrective action. Ross to contact Google to advise the same information that he already sent to Go Daddy in his effort to get the fraudulent website taken down. Apparent activity in Elyria indicates the likelihood that Amanda (Dave) not only has no intention of returning to honor but to continue with the dishonorable, dishonest path opposing OSJA which they began engaging in over a year ago.
5. Lancaster County Flag Day community celebration sponsorship. Each set of volunteers 'manning the booth' on June 14, 2025 from 9am to 3pm at Zane Square in downtown Lancaster is encouraged to bring documentation, flyers and a readiness to engage and educate the public **on your personal passion projects** and how those work into the peaceful, honorable, self-governance framework of OSJA.

7. National Liberty Alliance. Keith advises that John Darash recently filed a grievance with the US Supreme Court demanding Courts of Record access for Common Law Grand Jury business.
