for all grand juries to utilize when reeducating mankind on the rights/responsibilities
toward common law protections of one another.

Ultimately, "The Grand Jury is the fourth branch of government" is the guiding principle. The Bilateral Social Compact acts in common law as the "City Charter" acts under maritime codes/statutes.
