The State of Ohio respectfully requests this Court strike Defendant Joseph Senk's Criminal Complaint. On August 4, 2021, Defendant filed a complaint in this matter alleging that Judge Allison McCarty and many other individuals, including several Ohio Attorney General employees, committed federal felony offenses.
