Re: Response to your letter dated March 6, 2025, and demand to cease further communication regarding unrecognized claims of trespass and debt

Dear Mr. Mauger:

I am writing this letter on behalf of my client, the Fairfield County Health Department, in response to your letter dated March 6, 2025. While I appreciate your expression of concerns, I must clarify that the assertions made within your letter are unfounded and lack any legal basis.

All actions taken by the Fairfield County Health Department are in accordance with applicable laws and regulations. The role of the Health Department is to promote public health and safety in our community. The procedures and protocols followed by the Health Department are designed to lawfully further these goals. Thus, your claims of trespass and debt are not recognized under any legal framework, and I urge you to cease any further correspondence on this subject.

As you have been informed in prior correspondence, the Fairfield County Health Department does not recognize the validity of your claims. In any event, Crystal Warner is no longer employed by the Health Department as of February 14, 2025. As such, neither Ms. Warner nor the Health Department can respond to or engage in any matter you wish to raise pertaining to her former role. I urge you to cease any further communications regarding this matter, as they are not only unfounded but also disruptive and a waste of public resources.

The Health Department welcomes community input; however, please be advised that any further claims of this nature directed to the Health Department, or its current or former employees, are unwarranted and will not be entertained. Any continued communication threatening legal action or personal claims will be documented and may necessitate further legal action against you.

Thank you for your prompt attention to this matter. I trust that we can resolve this matter amicably and without further escalation.
