Old Business

I. Previous meeting minutes

II. Reports of Officers, Chairs and Committees

- a. **Treasury.** Keith: \$4.44 postage today for six responses (second notice) to County Clerks of Courts.

- i. Beverly expense listing is being sorted and will be reported next week.

b. Education Committee

- i. In Michael's absence this evening, Cristina shares her study of the InPower website (NoL Process) that was recommended by Anthony Pena in last Saturday's meeting. Although Anthony recommended the for-pay website (\$150) where they provide the fill-in-the-blank documents, the YouTube channel has some very comprehensive guide videos on the concept and practices involved in the Notice of Liability process; this may well be the chink in the de facto armor that gets our foot in the door. c. Public Affairs Chair

- i. Cristina yields her time to Keith to update on the cooperation and responses he is seeing from the 88 County Clerks of Courts. Interfacing with the existing governance structure to achieve true representation of mankind on the land requires that we are diligent in clear communications to those currently seated that we insist that they do the job they were sworn, under The Constitution, to perform. Please see recording. Keith and Cristina to meet tomorrow to discuss charting each county's response, to ensure she has final versions of communications to the counties and to finalize the BSC template document for County CoS to use on a statewide level.

d. Grand Jury Commission Report

- i. On Beverly's behalf, Keith details the replies he is getting on his "demand for Article II Court – room, magistrate, enforcement of Grand Jury Findings";

twenty-two counties have replied, to date. Two sent responses via Certified mail, half a dozen replied via email, only a small number have been rude. The common thread in these responses is the clerk taking it upon themselves to re-classify the Article II court claim as an Article III Civil Complaint and then they provide court rules for paying to have this complaint seated in their BAR operated jurisdiction. Only one clerk responded with a telephone call, honestly stating he was confused, giving Keith opportunity to explain the concepts of common law trespass harm claims, etc. This clerk did not subsequently offer a room/magistrate/enforcement support. Last Sunday Keith, Beverly and Cristina had a Zoom call where the appropriate “opportunity to cure” language was hammered out for the second notice to the Clerks who are responding. Julie points out that neither the first or second notice final language is posted yet on the website. Cristina thanks Julie for this proofreading correction of the website and goes on to ask for anyone who sees errors like this to bring it to her attention asap so she can correct those problems.

Open New Business: Moved Keith; Seconded Cristina;

- **Fairfield Family Forum** has kindly invited OSJA to attend their Flag Day celebration again this year, in Lancaster’s Zane Square Park, on June 14, 2026. Discussion is had regarding possible discounted sponsorship as well as their request that we provide a display of the progression showing the history of the American flag, perhaps a banner with the images. Ross is again heading up this task as was decided last year. Keith does still have some small flags to pass out to visitors to our booth/pavilion.

The steps taken by OSJA towards our goal of establishing the most credible and ‘correct’ Notice to mankind all over the world of our existence are a compilation of the steps taken by every other Assembly, and in fact, sovereign Nation=State’s processes.

In terms of international recognition, the final step Ohio needs to take is to formally hold our election of the one Representative and two Senators who would act as envoys between the 88 County Committees of Safety on Ohio and the similar representatives from the other peaceful Nation=States within the Perpetual Union as established through the Articles of Confederation.

Our 2022 State Bilateral Social Compact in Reciprocal Recognition with the America First Republic does establish that private membership association as the gathering space for what might loosely be referred to as a National Congress, and as Public Affairs Chair, Cristina was selected as the official representative to the Articles of Confederation private membership organization currently headed by Sean Beller. OSJA has not made any formal notation of election specifically for this representative in any other document (eg. The Bylaws). The Bylaws also lack any specific reference to the Bilateral Social Compact. In order to have our paperwork be secure in it's references, not only does the State need such language in the Bylaws but every County should be urged to have their own BSC that recognizes the OSJA State Committee of Safety as the base for one representative from each of the 88 County CoS to gather regularly to discuss matters of concern to the whole Nation=State. Cristina moves to table this multi-step topic to a future meeting, giving people time to consider their positions and the best way to accomplish this; Julie seconds; the matter is tabled to a future meeting.
