Old Business

I. Previous meeting minutes

b. Education Committee

- i. Michael continues to study his ongoing Ecclesia topic & requests a meeting with Dr. Anthony Pena on the Notice of Liability process discussed last week.

c. Public Affairs Chair

- i. Cristina talks about the upcoming 02/14/26 Lorain Totally Engaged Americans meeting where several candidates for State seats will be present and available for public interaction. All are encouraged to attend meetings like this in their local communities and interact. She then yields her time to Keith and Ross for updates on their respective claims and ongoing communications between themselves and government agents. Please see recording.

d. Grand Jury Commission Report

- i. On Beverly's behalf, Keith has no update beyond the progress he has made this week (see above).
- ii. Cristina and Ross point out that Beverly has asked us to research Article II Courts before this Saturday's meeting.

e. Fairfield Family Forum Flag Day – June 14, 2026

- i. Inquiry is being made about exchanging the requested task of researching and producing an History of American Flags banner for the \$250 sponsorship fee this year. Keith to update as he receives feedback.

- **State Bilateral Social Compact.**

Amendments are necessary. One specifically problematic Article is discussed and ways we, as a general assembly, and, as County Committees of Safety, can go about clarifying and correcting language that is no longer compatible with our goals/intentions/beliefs and directions to those who seek to represent mankind on the land.. Lengthy discussion is had.

There are **two** ways the language can be ‘corrected’ 1) each County establishes the corrective language within their local BSC, and 2) once we have an additional 75% more autographs (currently 60 men/women; would need another 180 men/women) to the State BSC, the entire signing body of the state compact can vote to modify that document to more current and appropriate language. The modification of the OSJA state document presses us to greatly improve our community outreach (**call for volunteers?**). Cristina moves to table the topic until a future meeting. Michael seconds.

Reminder that Saturday’s Zoom meeting aims to finalize the decision on date/location for our next quarterly meeting (if kept to the strictest schedule it should be this coming Saturday, 02/14/26). Ideally, we will set the recurring dates for quarterly meetings this weekend and determine locations as the dates approach. Early in our existence, and several times in the last three years, the general assembly has collectively agreed to have quarterly meetings ‘in the four corners of Ohio’. Because of heavier turnout in the southern counties, we have been meeting in the SE and SW corner counties most often but we do have VERY strong members who no longer attend electronically in the NW and NE corners of the state, but would attend if we were to arrive to them locally for a face to face gathering.
