greetings to the man or woman who at times acts as county clerk of court:

i, say: after many attempts to keep this matter private and to operate as a man with rights, no remedy has been given from any of the above; instead, only more trespasses; this has led to a current requirement for a court of record, to press claims of trespass and to present i, before a jury of peers, or before a man or woman who is competent at trespass law, there to keep the peace and put forth the orders of restoration of honor; i wish to press these claims on those whom i, believe have done trespasses on the rights of i, and whom have been noticed of these trespasses;

i, do require one of the following three, in order of preference:

- a petit jury, to hear and examine evidence supporting the claims;
- a grand jury, to affirm the necessity for a petit jury;
- a man or woman, well versed at law common to mankind, to act as magistrate, to verify outstanding unrebutted claims;

as i, do require a court which harms neither i, nor those who witness on behalf of i, all above must meet the following criteria:

no man or woman who serves as jurist, court officer, or attendant, shall have been injected with a "vaccine," at least since the covid rollout;


